## Overview

Learn how to perform internal and external audits of an environmental management system (EMS) against the requirements of ISO 14001 with this IEMA, CQI and IRCA certified ISO 14001 Lead Auditor training course.

The course gives delegates the skills and confidence to plan, conduct, report and follow up EMS audits. By the end of the course attendees will be able to:

- audit to assess conformance with ISO 14001 requirements
- identify whether the EMS is effectively implemented and maintained
- contribute to the continual improvement of the EMS

The course is built around a central case study that simulates a site audit, giving students practical experience in tackling audit tasks. Workshops, discussions and interactive tutorials cover important topics such as risk-based auditing, assessing environmental aspects and impacts, and EMS nonconformity writing.

Delegates are assessed through a combination of continuous assessment during the course and an online exam after the event.

## Who should attend?

This is a key course for those involved in auditing an EMS. It will be of benefit to a wide range of job roles and tasks, including those responsible for:

- undertaking internal audits, supplier audits and certification audits
- leading environmental management system (EMS) audits
- managing EMS audits
